You will be met at the Portcullis Gate of the castle by renowned piper Alan Harrison, and guided up to the great Square of one of the most icon castles in the world.

**Edinburgh Castle** ([www.edinburghcastle.gov.uk](http://www.edinburghcastle.gov.uk)) has been occupied for at least the two millennia. There was a royal castle on the rock from the reign of David the 1<sup>st</sup> in the 12th century until 1633 when its buildings became principally a military barracks. As one of the most important strongholds in the Kingdom of Scotland, Edinburgh Castle was involved in some 26 sieges in its 1100-year-old history, giving it a claim to having been the one of the most attacked fortresses in the world. It is also a wonderful place for a party, offering panoramic vistas across the city, the Firth of Forth and the southern uplands of Scotland and an opportunity to explore many of the national treasures during the evening.
